

STOCK DISEASES ORDINANCE 1969

No. 55 of 1969

An Ordinance to amend the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1954-1968*

[Assented to 10 December, 1969]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1969*.

Short title
and citation

(2.) The *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1954-1968* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1954-1969*.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.*

Commencement

3. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“7.—(1.) There shall be a Chief Inspector of Stock, who shall be appointed by the Administrator.

“(2.) A person shall not be appointed to be the Chief Inspector unless he is registered as or is, in the opinion of the Administrator, a fit and proper person to apply for registration as a veterinary surgeon under the *Veterinary Surgeons Ordinance 1960-1968*.”

4. Section 11 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words “The Minister” and inserting in their stead the words “The Administrator”.
