

SUPPLY OF SERVICES ORDINANCE 1965

No. 10 of 1965

An Ordinance to amend the *Supply of Services Ordinance 1952-1962*

[Assented to 8th April, 1965.]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1962*, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Supply of Services Ordinance 1965*.

(2.) The *Supply of Services Ordinance 1952-1962* is in this Ordinance referred to as the *Principal Ordinance*.

(3.) The *Principal Ordinance*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Supply of Services Ordinance 1952-1965*.

Commence-
ment.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.*

3. Section five D of the *Principal Ordinance* is amended—

(a) by omitting the words “the person in occupation of the premises on which the service is supplied” and inserting in their stead the words “the person to whom the service is supplied”; and

(b) by omitting the words “by registered post” and inserting in their stead the words “by certified mail”.

Regulations.

4. Section seven of the *Principal Ordinance* is amended by inserting after paragraph (b) the following paragraph:—

“(ba) the provision of financial assistance to prescribed persons to enable them to connect their dwelling houses to sewers;”.
