An Ordinance to amend the *Special Purposes Leases Ordinance*

[Assented to 9 November 1978]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

| Short title | 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the <i>Special Purposes Leases Ordinance (No. 2) 1978</i> . |
| Principal Ordinance | 2. The <i>Special Purposes Leases Ordinance</i> is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. |
| Commencement | 3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the date on which the <i>Aboriginal Land Ordinance 1978</i> comes into operation.* |
| Definitions | 4. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—
(a) by inserting before the definition of “Aboriginal reserve” the following definition:
“ ‘Aboriginal Land Council’ means the Aboriginal Land Council established under section 21 of the <i>Aboriginal Land Rights (Northern Territory) Act 1976</i> for the area that contains the particular area of land;” and
(b) by omitting the definition of “the Board”. |
| Repeal of certain provisions | 5. Sections 4A, 4B, 4C and 4D of the Principal Ordinance are repealed. |
| Lessee may transfer, &c., his lease | 6. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting “the Board” (wherever occurring) and substituting “the Aboriginal Land Council”. |
| Acquisition of land in a reserve by a non-approved person | 7. Section 6A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting “the Board” (wherever occurring) and substituting “the Aboriginal Land Council”. |
