TREASON (REPEAL OF IMPERIAL ACTS AND STATE ACTS) ORDINANCE 1968

No. 57 of 1968

An Ordinance to amend the Law relating to Treason

[Assented to 18 September, 1968]

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1968, as follows:—

Short title and citation 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Treason (Repeal of Imperial Acts and State Acts) Ordinance 1968.

Commencement

- 2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette.*
- 25 Edw. 3, stat. 5, c.2 ceases to be in force as a law of the Territory
- 3. On and from the commencement of this Ordinance the Imperial Act 25 Edward III, Statute 5, chapter 2 shall cease to be in force in the Territory as a law of the Territory.

Imperial Acts and State Acts of South Australia relating to treason cease to be in force as laws of the Territory 4. On and from the commencement of this Ordinance all Imperial Acts relating to treason and all Acts of the State of South Australia relating to treason that are in force in the Territory as laws of the Territory at the commencement of this Ordinance shall, to the extent that they relate to the offence of treason, cease to be in force in the Territory as laws of the Territory.
