MINING (ROYALTY SUSPENSION) ORDINANCE 1943.*

An Ordinance to suspend the operation of sub-section (2.) of section fifty of the Mining Ordinance 1939-1942.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mining (Royalty Suspension) Ordinance 1943.*

Commencement. 2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Suspension of royalties.

3. The operation of sub-section (2.) of section fifty of the *Mining Ordinance* 1939-1942 is hereby suspended until a date to be fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*, and no longer, but in any event not longer than twelve months after His Majesty ceases to be engaged in War.
