- "auctioneer's licence" means an auctioneer's licence under the Auctioneers Ordinance 1935-1955;
- "clerk's licence" means a clerk's licence under the Auctioneers Ordinance 1935-1955.
- (2.) In these Regulations a reference to a form by number shall be read as a reference to the form so numbered in the Schedule to these Regulations.
- (3.) Strict compliance with the forms contained in the Schedule to these Regulations is not necessary and substantial compliance with those forms is sufficient.
- 4. An application for an auctioneer's licence shall be in accordance with Form of Form 1.
