

AUCTIONEERS REGULATIONS*

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1. These Regulations may be cited as the Auctioneers Regulations.* Citation.
2. The Auctioneers Regulations† are repealed. Repeal.
- 3.—(1.) In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears— Interpretation.
“auctioneer’s licence” means an auctioneer’s licence under the *Auctioneers Ordinance* 1935-1955;
“clerk’s licence” means a clerk’s licence under the *Auctioneers Ordinance* 1935-1955.
(2.) In these Regulations a reference to a form by number shall be read as a reference to the form so numbered in the Schedule to these Regulations.
(3.) Strict compliance with the forms contained in the Schedule to these Regulations is not necessary and substantial compliance with those forms is sufficient.
4. An application for an auctioneer’s licence shall be in accordance with Form 1. Form of application for auctioneer’s licence.
5. An application for the renewal of an auctioneer’s licence shall be in accordance with Form 2. Form of application for renewal of auctioneer’s licence.
6. An auctioneer’s licence or the renewal of an auctioneer’s licence shall be in accordance with Form 3. Form of auctioneer’s licence or renewal of auctioneer’s licence.
7. An application for a clerk’s licence shall be in accordance with Form 4. Form of application for clerk’s licence.
8. A clerk’s licence shall be in accordance with Form 5. Form of clerk’s licence.
