Definitions.

Parking of vehicles at intersections.

Vehicles to be parked within certain areas.

Standing close to curb.

Prohibition of parking in certain areas.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Alice Springs Administration (Control of Traffic) Regulations.*
2. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears-
"footway" includes every footpath, lane, thoroughfare, or other public place commonly used by pedestrians and not by vehicular traffic;
"intersection" means the area embraced within the prolongation of the building lines of two or more streets which join at an angle, whether or not one street crosses the other;
" street" means any street, road, terrace, thoroughfare, lane or place open to, or used by, the public within the town of Alice Springs;
" vehicle" means any means of conveyance which runs on wheels but does not include any vehicle used on a railway.
3. No person shall park or rank any vehicle within twenty feet of the boundary of the area embraced in any intersection.

Penalty: Five pounds.
4. No person shall leave any vehicle parked stationary whether attended or unattended unless there is a space of not less than three feet between the front of such vehicle and the rear of any other vehicle, or, if such vehicle is reversed into position, unless there is a space of not less than three feet between the rear of such vehicle and the front of any other vehicle.

Penalty: Five pounds.
5. Except when necessary in obedience to traffic regulations the driver of a vehicle shall not stop or stand or allow such vehicle to remain stationary in a street other than parallel with the edge of the footway headed in the direction of traffic and with the nearside wheels of the vehicle within eighteen inches of the edge of the footway on the nearside:

Provided that this regulation shall not apply to a vehicle being driven across the intersection the driver of which vehicle gives way to traffic travelling across the intersection at right angles.

Penalty: Five pounds.
6. No person shall leave any motor truck, lorry, semi-trailer, or other freight carrying vehicles, or vehicle adapted for, or capable of, carrying freight (other than a utility truck of not more than fifteen hundredweight carrying capacity) stationary in those areas specified in the Schedule to these Regulations either attended, or unattended, except for the purpose of loading or unloading, and then only whilst engaged in loading or unloading and for a period not exceeding thirty minutes at one time.

Penalty: Five pounds.

THE SCHEDULE.

1. That part of Todd Street between Wills Terrace and Gregory Terrace.
2. That part of Parsons Street between Todd Street and Hartley Street.
