FOOD AND DRUGS (WASTE BEER) REGULATIONS*

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Food and Drugs (Waste Beer) Regulations.*

Disposal of waste ale and

2. The licensee of any premises licensed under the *Licensing Ordinance* 1939-1949 shall cause a fixed tray to be provided under the outlet of any ale or beer pump installed in the bar-room of the premises, for the purpose of receiving ale or beer which drips from the pump or is spilt or overflows, in the course of serving ale or beer to the public, such tray to be connected and kept connected, to the satisfaction of an inspector, with the drainage system of those premises.

Penalty.

3. Any person who is convicted of an offence against the last preceding regulation shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Twenty pounds, and, when the offence is a continuing offence, a penalty not exceeding Five pounds for every day during which the offence continues, but, so that the total of such penalties shall not exceed One hundred pounds.
