FIREARMS REGULATIONS*

PART I.—PRELIMINARY.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms Regulations.*

- 2. In these Regulations, a reference to a Schedule shall be read as a Interpretati n. reference to a Schedule to these Regulations and a reference to a Form shall be read as a reference to a Form contained in the Schedules.
 - 3. These Regulations are divided into Parts, as follows:—

Part I.—Preliminary (Regulations 1-3).

Part II.—Firearms (Regulations 4-6B).

Part III.—Pistols and High Powered Firearms (Regulations 6c-13B).

Part IV.—Gun Dealers (Regulations 14-18).

Part V.—Miscellaneous (Regulations 19-25).

PART II .-- FIREARMS.

- 4. Application for registration of a firearm shall be made by lodging Form of a form of application in accordance with Form 1 of the First Schedule with Application the officer-in-charge of the nearest police station.
- 5.—(1.) The Register of Firearms to be kept by the Registrar shall be in Register of accordance with Form 2 of the First Schedule.
- (2.) The register to be kept by a deputy registrar shall be in accordance with Form 5 of the First Schedule.
- 6. A Certificate of Registration in accordance with Form 3 of the First Form of Schedule shall be issued to the owner of a registered firearm.

 Certificate of Registration.
- 6A. The owner of a firearm which is registered under the Firearms Change of Ordinance 1956 shall, if he changes his address, furnish particulars of the address. change of address to the Registrar within one month in accordance with Form 2A of the First Schedule.
- 6B. The owner of a firearm which is registered under the *Firearms* sale of *Ordinance* 1956 shall, if he sells or disposes of the firearm, give notice in accordance with Form 3A of the First Schedule to the Registrar within one week of the sale or disposal stating the name and address of the person to whom he sold or otherwise disposed of the firearm.

where, in each class, the decimal point and the first two figures indicate in inches the calibre of a rifle of the class and the last two figures indicate in grains the weight of the propellant charge commonly used to fire a bullet from such a rifle.

- 11.—(1.) If a pistol or high powered firearm in respect of which a licence is applied for is in the possession or custody of an applicant at the time when an application is made, the applicant shall, if so required, produce the pistol or high powered firearm to the officer-in-charge of the police station at which the application is lodged for inspection by the officer.
- (2.) The officer shall ascertain that the description of the pistol or high powered firearm set out in the application is correct and he shall initial the description of the pistol or high powered firearm in the application.

12. A person who is the holder of a pistol licence or a high powered firearm licence shall produce his licence for inspection to the officer-incharge of the police station at which the application is lodged when making application for renewal of the licence.

- 16. The Register of Gun Dealers' Licences shall be maintained in Register of accordance with Form 7 of the Second Schedule.
- 17.—(1.) deliver up to the officer of police to whom application for renewal is made, the expired licence or certificate, or furnish satisfactory proof that the same has been lost or destroyed.

Shooting galleries.

- 23.—(1.) A room, gallery, saloon, land or premises, used for the purpose of practising shooting with pea rifles, saloon guns or other firearms, and whether on payment or otherwise, shall be deemed to be a shooting gallery.
- (2.) A shooting gallery shall be conducted in a manner determined by the member of the Police Force in charge of the police district in which the shooting gallery is situated.

- 24.—(1.) An appeal against the decision of the Registrar under Section 30 of the Firearms Ordinance, 1956 shall be instituted within twenty-eight days from the day on which the decision is made known to an applicant.
- (2.) An appeal is instituted by notice of appeal stating the grounds thereof which shall be served on the Registrar and filed in the Court to which the appeal is made.

Penalty.

25. A person who contravenes or fails to comply with a provision of these Regulations or fails to comply with a requirement of an order or notice thereunder shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, upon conviction, to a penalty not exceeding Fifty pounds.
