PROHIBITED DRUGS REGULATIONS*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prohibited Drugs Regulations.* Citation.

2. The Schedule to the Prohibited Drugs Ordinance 1963 is amended Amendment of Schedule to by omitting the words—

"Thalidomide.

Ketobemidone.

Diamorphone (Heroin) and the salts of the drug Diamorphine (Heroin)."

and inserting in their stead the words-

" Allylisopropylacetyl urea

Amidopyrine (aminopyrine) and derivatives of the drug amidopyrine (aminopyrine), including dipyrone

Diamorphine (heroin) and the salts of the drug diamorphine (heroin)

Ketobemidone

Methyl cinchophen (methyl ester of phenylcinchoninic acid)

Thalidomide ".

3. Regulation 1964, No. 6, is repealed.
