

PHARMACY REGULATIONS*

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pharmacy Regulations.*

Meetings of the Board.

2.—(1) Meetings of the Board shall be held at such times and places as the Chairman determines.

(2) No resolution passed, or act, matter or thing done or authorized to be done, by or at any meeting, shall be rescinded, amended, cancelled or revoked at any subsequent meeting unless notice of the proposed rescission, amendment, cancellation or revocation has been given in the notice convening the meeting.

(3) Notice of any motion or resolution intended to be proposed at any meeting shall be given to the Chairman in writing at least seven clear days prior to the meeting, and such notice when so delivered shall be embodied in the business paper and sent to members.

(4) Upon the signing of the Minutes of any meeting by the Chairman at a subsequent meeting, those Minutes shall be binding and conclusive for all purposes.

Particulars in Register.

3. The particulars to be entered in the Register of Pharmacists with respect to the registration of any person shall be as follow:—

- Number;
- Date of Registration;
- Name of Pharmacist;
- Professional Address;
- Qualifications.

Fee for certificate of registration.

4.—(1) The fee for registration of a person as a pharmacist shall be One pound one shilling.

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(3.) The Board may issue a temporary permit under section thirty-six of the *Pharmacy Ordinance* 1936 without fee.

No fees payable by pharmacists in employment of Government.

5. Notwithstanding the provisions of the last preceding regulation, no fees shall be payable by any pharmacist in the employment of the Public Service or Administration of the Territory or in the employment of the Commonwealth.
