REMOVAL OF PRISONERS (TERRITORIES) **REGULATIONS***

Short title.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Removal of Prisoners (Territories) Regulations.*

- 2.—(1.) Where a prisoner has been removed in pursuance of the Removal of Prisoners (Territories) Act 1923 to any State or Territory, that prisoner may which removed make application in writing to the Secretary, Prime Minister's Department, Canberra, to be sent free of cost to the Territory from which he was removed.
 - (2.) Any application made under the last preceding sub-regulation shall be lodged with the Secretary, Prime Minister's Department, Canberra, within fourteen days from the date of the prisoner's discharge at the expiration of his sentence.
