# STOCK DISEASES REGULATIONS\*

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Stock Diseases Regulations. Citation.
- 2. Regulations 1956, No. 3, are repealed.

Repeal.

- 3.—(1.) In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears, Definitions. "the Ordinance" means the Stock Diseases Ordinance 1954-1955.
- (2.) In these Regulations, a reference to a form by letter is a reference to a Form so lettered in the Second Schedule to these Regulations.
- 4. For the purposes of the Ordinance, each of the diseases specified Prescribed in the First Schedule to these Regulations is a prescribed disease.
- 5. A permission granted by an inspector for the purposes of section 13 Permission to drive, &c., stock into, &c. of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form A. quarantine area.
- 6. A permission granted by an inspector for the purposes of section 14 Permission to enter, &c. of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form B. quarantine area.
- 7. A permission granted by an inspector for the purposes of section 18 Permission to drive stock of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form C. into protected
- 8. A notice under section 24 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance Notice of with Form D. import stock.
- 9. For the purposes of paragraph (b) of section 24 of the Ordinance, Persons a prescribed authority is a veterinary officer, or an inspector of stock, authorized to employed as such by the Government of any State or Territory of the permit. Commonwealth.
- 10. A permit to import stock into the Northern Territory shall be in Import permit. accordance with Form E.
- 11. An order given by an inspector pursuant to the Ordinance shall be Orders by in writing in accordance with Form F and shall be served personally on inspectors. the person to whom it is directed.
- 12. When an inspector, in pursuance of the powers conferred on him Inspector to by the Ordinance, destroys, or causes to be destroyed, any stock, he shall, give certificate when stock at the time of so doing, deliver a certificate in accordance with Form G ordered to be to the person in charge of the stock.
- 13. A person shall not feed to swine, or suffer swine under his control Unboiled food to eat, waste food or refuse which has not been boiled continuously for at not to be fed to swine. least thirty minutes.

Penalty: One hundred pounds.
