

WATER SUPPLIES DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS*

- Short title.** 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Supplies Development Regulations.*
- Definitions.** 2. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—
 “applicant” means a person who has made an application for an advance under the Ordinance;
 “application” means an application for an advance under the Ordinance;
 “the Ordinance” means the *Water Supplies Development Ordinance* 1960.
- Form of application.** 3.—(1.) An application shall be in accordance with the Form set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.
 (2.) Strict compliance with the Form is not necessary and substantial compliance is sufficient.
- Deposit.** 4. The deposit to accompany an application shall be Two pounds.
- Rate of interest.** 5.—(1.) The rate of interest in respect of an advance is the long term bond rate.
 (2.) In this regulation, “the long term bond rate” means—
 (a) the interest rate per annum payable in respect of the Commonwealth securities having a currency of not less than five years that are being offered in Australia for public subscription at the date the advance is made; or
 (b) where no such securities are being offered at that date, the interest rate per annum payable in respect of the Commonwealth securities having a currency of not less than five years that were last offered in Australia for public subscription prior to that date,
 but where securities referred to in paragraph (a) or (b) of this sub-regulation are or were being offered simultaneously for currencies of different periods each of not less than five years, does not include the interest rate per annum payable in respect of any of those securities other than the securities having the longest currency.
- Attendance of applicant.** 6. The Commissioner may require an applicant to attend personally before him at such place and time as the Commissioner specifies for the purpose of being interrogated by the Commissioner and the applicant shall truthfully and, if so required, in writing answer any question put to him by the Commissioner.
