An Act for the appropriation of revenue of the State for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1981, and for other purposes

[Assented to 13 November 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Appropriation Act (No. 2), 1980".

Further issue.

2. Out of the moneys paid to the State by the Commonwealth, and any other General Revenue of the State not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there may be issued and applied such a further sum as will, together with all sums issued and applied pursuant to the Acts (other than this Act) authorizing the issue and application out of the General Revenue of any moneys for the public service of the State for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1981, amount to the sum of one thousand one hundred and eighty-nine million, eight hundred and fourteen thousand dollars.

Appropriation of General Revenue.

- 3. (1) The sum of one thousand one hundred and eighty-nine million, eight hundred and fourteen thousand dollars referred to in section 2 of this Act is appropriated for the public service of the State for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1981, for the purposes mentioned in the schedule.
 - (2) If—
 - (a) during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1981, any increases of salaries or wages become payable by the State or in relation to any prescribed establishment pursuant to any return made under the Acts relating to the public service, or pursuant to any regulation or any award, order or determination of a court or other body empowered to fix salaries or wages;

and

(b) those increases, together with increases in pay-roll tax arising therefrom, were not provided for in the estimates of expenditure for that financial year,

the Governor may, by warrant under section 32a of the Public Finance Act, 1936, as amended, appropriate out of the General Revenue of the State such amounts as are equal to those increases of salaries, wages and pay-roll tax and those appropriations shall be additional to the appropriations made by virtue of subsection (1) of this section, and the aggregate amount which may be appropriated under section 32a of the Public Finance Act, 1936, as amended, for that financial year shall be increased by the amount appropriated pursuant to this subsection.

(3) The Governor may, by warrant under section 32a of the Public Finance Act, 1936, as amended, appropriate out of the General Revenue of the State any money required to meet further expenditure beyond the amounts provided in the estimates of expenditure for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1981, for costs of electricity supplied to the Engineering and Water Supply Department for pumping water and the aggregate amount which may be appropriated under section 32a of the Public Finance Act, 1936, as amended, for that financial year shall be increased by the amount appropriated pursuant to this subsection.

(4) In this section—

"prescribed establishment" means any establishment in respect of which a grant towards its operation or maintenance has been included in the estimates of expenditure for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1981.

4. This issue and payment by the Treasurer, from time to time, of any Treasurer to sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the of Governor, whole the amount hereinbefore specified, in such portions as the Governor by receipt of directs by any orders in writing signed by him and countersigned by the Chief Secretary, is hereby authorized; and the Treasurer shall, in his accounts, be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly; and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums are so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sums for which the receipts are given, and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.

5. If the moneys paid to the State by the Commonwealth and the General Power to issue Revenue of the State are insufficient to make the payments authorized by section than revenue 3 of this Act, moneys may be issued to make good the deficiency out of loan recommendation funds or other public funds or out of moneys raised by way of bank overdraft.

6. The Treasurer may—

Power to make payments.

(a) out of the moneys appropriated by this Act and included in the estimates of expenditure for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1981;

or

(b) out of any money which may be appropriated pursuant to subsection (2) of section 3 of this Act,

make any payment notwithstanding that the payment is in respect of a period prior to the first day of July, 1980.

Expenditure from Hospitals Fund.

- 7. The Treasurer may out of the account in the Treasury known as the "Hospitals Fund" expend such sums as may, in accordance with any Act, be available therein for the purposes of the provision, maintenance, development and improvement of public hospitals and equipment for public hospitals: But such expenditure shall not exceed in the aggregate—
 - (a) during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1981, the sum of thirty million dollars;
 - (b) during the period between the thirtieth day of June, 1981, and the commencement of the Act for the appropriation of revenue of the State for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1982, the sum of twelve million five hundred thousand dollars.

Hospitals and public health.

- 8. (1) All moneys paid to the State by the Commonwealth by way of grant or payment under any Act or Acts of the Commonwealth relating to hospitals or public health shall be credited to such special accounts in the books of the Treasurer as the Treasurer shall determine and the Treasurer shall issue and pay out of the moneys so credited such sums as are required for the purposes specified in that Act or, as the case may be, respectively specified in those Acts.
- (2) All moneys received in relation to hospitals or public health that would, but for this subsection, be payable to the General Revenue of the State, shall be paid to such special accounts in the books of the Treasurer as the Treasurer shall determine and are hereby appropriated for the purposes of hospitals and public health and the Treasurer shall issue and pay out of the moneys so appropriated such sums as are required for those purposes in addition to such other sums as may be appropriated for those purposes otherwise than by this subsection.

Payments to be in addition to other payments.

9. Any amount appropriated by this Act may be paid for the purpose for which it is so appropriated, in addition to any other amount appropriated by law for that purpose.
