

ORDINANCE Enacted by the Governor of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

For the Further Appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-nine, and for the General Appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty.

[3rd August, 1849.]

WHEREAS by the Laws relating to the Customs and Trade, and Preamble. other Acts and Ordinances of this Province, certain duties, fines, and other moneys, are or may be imposed, levied, and collected, to be paid to the Colonial Treasurer, on behalf of Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, for the public uses of the Province and support of the Government thereof.

Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof...That out of the said duties, and the produce of all or any other the General Public Revenues of the Province, not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there shall or may be further issued and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, any sums of money not exceeding in amount, respectively, the several sums of money hereinafter specified, that is to say:

Appropriation of General Revenue.

FIRST

Excess of Expenditure 1848-9.

Supplementary Charge for the year 1849—

Civil, Judicial, and Medical Establishments.

FIRST—For defraying the excess of Expenditure for the Government Establishments, Miscellaneous Services, and Public Works, beyond the Grants for the year ending the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-nine, the sum of Five Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty-eight Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Ten Pence.

And be it Enacted—That the Colonial Treasurer shall issue to pay on the orders of the Governor, and and pay, from time to time, any sum or sums of money, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons, and in such portions, as the Governor for the time being shall, by any order or orders in writing, signed by him, from time to time, direct and the said Treasurer shall, in his accounts, be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders, accordingly; and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid, shall be to him a full discharge for the sum or sums for which the same receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit in account ac- $T_0$ cordingly.
