An Act to enable the Governor to extend the Term of Office of the present Agent-General.

[Assented to, November 21st, 1923.]

DE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Agent-General Act Amend- Short titles. ment Act, 1923."

(2) The Agent-General Act, 1901 (hereinafter referred to as "the No. 769 of 1901. principal Act"), and this Act may be cited as the "Agent-General Acts, 1901 and 1923."

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 6 of the principal Act, the Governor may extend for a further period of twelve months the term of office of the person who, at the passing of this Act, holds the General for twelve months. office of Agent-General for South Australia in the United Kingdom.
