An Act to amend the Architects Act, 1939.

[Assented to 3 December 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

- Short title.           1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Architects Act Amendment Act, 1987".
- (2) The Architects Act, 1939, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- Amendment of s. 32—  
Qualifications for registration.
2. Section 32 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by inserting "or" after subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (b);
- and
- (b) by striking out subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (b) and "or" occurring immediately before that subparagraph.
- Amendment of s. 35—  
Professional misconduct.
3. Section 35 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after its present contents (now to be designated as subsection (1)) the following subsection:
- (2) A registered architect is not guilty of professional misconduct by reason of the publication of an advertisement if the advertisement is published in accordance with the by-laws of the board.
- Insertion of new ss. 47a and 47b.
4. The following sections are inserted after section 47 of the principal Act:
- 47a. (1) The board must, on or before 31 March in each year, submit to the Minister a report on the administration of this Act during the 12 months that ended on the preceding 31 December.
- (2) The Minister must, as soon as practicable after receipt of the report, cause a copy of the report to be laid before each House of Parliament.
- Annual report.

Immunity from  
liability.

47b. (1) No liability attaches to—

(a) a member of the board;

(b) the registrar;

or

(c) any other person engaged in the administration of this Act,  
for an honest act or omission in the exercise or purported exercise of  
a power or function under this Act.

(2) A liability that would, but for subsection (1), lie against a  
person on whom immunity is conferred by that subsection lies instead  
against the board.
