An Act to amend the Aged Citizens Clubs (Subsidies) Act, 1963-1969.

[Assented to 21st October, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Aged Citizens Clubs (Subsidies) Act Amendment Act, 1971".

(2) The Aged Citizens Clubs (Subsidies) Act, 1963-1969, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Aged Citizens Clubs (Subsidies) Act, 1963-1971".

(3) The Aged Citizens Clubs (Subsidies) Act, 1963-1969, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 2—
Interpretation.**

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from the definition of "council" the passage "The City of Whyalla Commission and".

3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (4) the passage "six thousand dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "ten thousand dollars".
