An Act to amend the Alsatian Dogs Act, 1934-1979.

[Assented to 17th April, 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Alsatian Dogs Act Amendment Act, 1980". Short titles.

(2) The Alsatian Dogs Act, 1934-1979, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Alsatian Dogs Act, 1934-1980".

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the passage "commonly known as" the passage, ' "German Shepherd dog" ', Amendment of principal Act, s. 2—
Interpretation.

3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (4) the following subsection:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 3—
Prohibition of keeping Alsatian dogs in certain parts of State.

(4a) This Act shall not apply within any part of the State to which the Governor by regulation declares that this Act shall not apply.
