### No. 17 of 1957.

An Act to suspend further the levy and collection of amusements duty under the Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1956.

[Assented to 24th October, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the "Amusements Duty (Further Suspension) Act, 1957". Short title.
2. In this Act "amusements duty", "amusement", and "admission" have the meanings assigned to them in Part IV of the Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1956. Interpretation.
3. No amusements duty shall be charged, levied, or paid on any payment for admission to any amusement held before the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-one. Suspension of amusements duty.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
