An Act to suspend the levy and collection of amusements duty under the Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1953.

[Assented to 16th December, 1954.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Amusements Duty (Further Suspension) Act, 1954".

Interpretation.

2. In this Act "amusements duty", "amusement" and "admission" have the meanings assigned to them in Part IV of the Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1953.

Suspension of amusements duty.

3. No amusements duty shall be charged, levied, or paid on any payment for admission to any amusement held before the first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
