An Act to suspend the levy and collection of amusements duty under the Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1953.

[Assented to 16th December, 1954.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

- Short title.** **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Amusements Duty (Further Suspension) Act, 1954".
- Interpretation.** **2.** In this Act "amusements duty", "amusement" and "admission" have the meanings assigned to them in Part IV of the Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1953.
- Suspension of amusements duty.** **3.** No amusements duty shall be charged, levied, or paid on any payment for admission to any amusement held before the first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
