No. 128 of 1974**An Act to amend the Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act, 1971-1973.***[Assented to 12th December, 1974]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act Amendment Act, 1974".

(2) The Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act, 1971-1973, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act, 1971-1974".

**Commence-

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

**Amendment of

Composition of
the Trust.**

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by striking out from subsection (1) the word "Subject" being the first word in that subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "The trustees in office immediately before the commencement of the Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act Amendment Act, 1974, shall, by force of this subsection, on that commencement vacate their respective offices and on and from that commencement, subject";
- (b) by striking out from paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the word "four" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "five";
- (c) by striking out from paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the passage "two shall be persons" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "one shall be a person";

and

(d) by striking out subsection (3) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(3) If the Minister has given the Council notice in writing requiring the Council within the time specified in the notice (being not less than six weeks) to nominate a person for appointment as a trustee under paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section and the Council fails to nominate the person required within the time specified, the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Minister, appoint a person as a trustee in place of the person in respect of the nomination of whom the failure occurred and that person so appointed shall be deemed for all purposes to have been nominated under that paragraph.
