An Act to amend the Art Gallery Act, 1939-1978.

[Assented to 7th December, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Art Gallery Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1978".

(2) The Art Gallery Act, 1939-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Art Gallery Act, 1939-1978".

2. Section 18 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "any institution or, with the consent of the Minister to any person" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "any person or body of persons";

and

(b) by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:—

(1a) The Board shall observe any policy or direction made or given by the Minister in relation to the exercise of powers conferred by subsection (1) of this section.
