An Act to amend the Art Gallery Act, 1939-1974.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Art Gallery Act Amendment Act, 1975".
- (2) The Art Gallery Act, 1939-1974, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Art Gallery Act, 1939-1975".

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of long title of principal Act.

3. The long title to the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "National Gallery at Adelaide" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Art Gallery of South Australia".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 3—

- s. 3— Interpretation.
- 4. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the definition of "art gallery" and inserting in lieu thereof the following definition:—

"art gallery" means the Art Gallery of South Australia.

Repeal of s. 16 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place5. Section 16 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:—

Powers and functions of the board.

- 16. (1) The functions of the board are as follows:—
 - (a) to undertake the care and control of the art gallery and of all lands and premises placed under the care and control of the board;
 - (b) to undertake the care and control of all works of art, exhibits and other personal property acquired for the purposes of the art gallery;

- (c) to assist in the promotion and supervision of art galleries and collections of art and any body or association established for the promotion of art within the State;
- (d) to advise the Minister and any organization referred to in paragraph (c) of this subsection on matters of general policy relating to art galleries and collections of art;
- (e) to advise the Minister, local government authorities and any other authority or body on the provision, selection and maintenance of works of art for public places in the State;

and

- (f) such other functions as may be necessary or incidental to the foregoing.
- (2) The board shall have and may exercise such powers as are necessary for or incidental to the carrying out of its functions.
- (3) In the exercise of its powers and the performance of its functions under this Act, the board may—
 - (a) receive, take or purchase any work of art, exhibit or personal property;
 - (b) sell or exchange any such work of art, exhibit or personal property or any work of art, exhibit or personal property under the care or control of the board.
