An Act to amend the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1890, Amendment Act, 1897."

[*Assented to, October 30th, 1901.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. Section 5 of the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1890, Amendment Act, 1897," is hereby repealed, and the following section shall be substituted in lieu thereof:—

Section 5 of No. 678 repealed.

2. Every association incorporated or purporting to be incorporated under the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1858," or the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1890," is hereby declared to be an association within the meaning of section 189 of the "Companies Act, 1892."

Section 189 of "Companies Act, 1892," to apply to associations.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
