## No. 1564.

An Act to amend the Acts Interpretation Act, 1915.

[Assented to, November 14th, 1923.]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Acts Interpretation Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1923."

(2) The Acts Interpretation Act, 1915 (hereinafter referred to No. 1215 of 1915. as "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Acts Interpretation Acts, 1915 and 1923."

2. Section 4 of the principal Act shall be read as if the following definition had at the time of the passing of that Act been included therein:—

"Master" or "Master of the Supreme Court" includes the Deputy Master of the Supreme Court and any other person to whom the duties of the Master are for the time being assigned.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—  
"Master" includes  
"Deputy Master."
