An Act to amend the Acts Interpretation Act 1915.

[Assented to 12 May 1994]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Acts Interpretation (Monetary Amounts) Amendment Act 1994*.

(2) The *Acts Interpretation Act 1915* is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Insertion of s. 45

2. The following section is inserted after section 44 of the principal Act:

Rounding down of monetary amounts

45. An enactment providing for the calculation and payment of a tax, fee, charge, or other amount must be construed as if it provided that the calculated amount, if not an exact multiple of 5 cents, is to be rounded down to the highest multiple of 5 cents that is less than that amount.
