**An Act to amend the Advances to Settlers Act,
1930-1968.**

[Assented to 20th August, 1970.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia,
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Advances to Settlers Act Amendment Act, 1970".

(2) The Advances to Settlers Act, 1930-1968, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Advances to Settlers Act, 1930-1970".

(3) The Advances to Settlers Act, 1930-1968, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 12a—
Special provision for the making of advances for the erection of dwelling houses.

2. Section 12a of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "eight thousand dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "nine thousand dollars".
