An Act to further amend the Advances to Settlers on Crown Lands Act, 1914.

[Assented to, November 16th, 1916.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of the Consent of the Parliament of the Parliam with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Advances to Settlers Short titles. on Crown Lands Act Further Amendment Act, 1916."
- (2) The Advances to Settlers on Crown Lands Acts, 1914 and Lands Act, 1914, is 1915, and this Act may be cited together as the "Advances to to as "the principal Settlers on Crown Lands Acts, 1914 to 1916." Act."

hereinafter referred

- (3) The Advances to Settlers on Crown Lands Act, 1914, is No. 1166 of 1914. hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in Incorporation with section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Commencement proclamation.
 - 4. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the definitions of "Deputy Surveyor-General" and "Surveyor-General" therein, and

- (b) by inserting therein the following definitions:—
 - "Assistant Secretary for Lands" means the person for the time being holding the office of Assistant Secretary for Lands:
 - "Secretary for Lands" means the person for the time being holding the office of Secretary for Lands.

Amendment of section 6—

Members of Advances to Settlers Board.

- 5. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended so as to read as follows:—
 - 6. (1) The members for the time being of the Land Board, the Secretary for Lands, and the Assistant Secretary for Lands shall be the members of the Board.
 - (2) The Secretary for Lands shall be the Chairman of the Board.
