An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1934-1981.

Reserved 17 December 1981 Royal Assent proclaimed 8 April 1982

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles,

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1981".
- (2) The Constitution Act, 1934-1981, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Constitution Act, 1934-1981".

Amendment of s. 73— Salary of the

- 2. Section 73 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (3) and substituting the following subsections:
  - (3) Where a Governor retires after completing nine-tenths or more of the term for which he was appointed his entitlement to salary shall be calculated as if he had completed that term.
  - (4) In determining whether a Governor has completed nine-tenths or more of the term for which he was appointed, periods of furlough shall not be counted as part of the period of service of the Governor.
    - (5) In this section—
      - "consumer price index" means the quarterly consumer price index number for Adelaide prepared and published by the Commonwealth Statistician:
      - "furlough", in relation to a Governor, means absence from office for recreational purposes for a continuous period of more than one month.
