## No. 56 of 1953.

An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1934-1951.

{ *Reserved 26th November, 1953.* }  
 { *Royal Assent proclaimed 24th June, 1954.* }

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Constitution Act Short titles. Amendment Act (No. 2), 1953 "

(2) The Constitution Act, 1934-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Constitution Act, 1934-1953 "

(3) The Constitution Act, 1934-1951, is hereinafter called " the principal Act "

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and Incorporation. that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the Enactment of s. 73c of principal Act— principal Act after section 73b thereof :—

73c. (1) There shall also be paid to the Governor in Allowance for salaries of staff. each financial year an allowance for payment of the salaries of his staff, at the rate of two thousand six hundred and fifty pounds a year.

(2) The said allowance shall—

(a) accrue due from day to day ;

(b) be apportionable in point of time ;

(c) be paid monthly by the Treasurer out of the general revenue of the State.

(3) Whenever the government of the State is administered during any period by the Lieutenant-Governor or any other person appointed for the purpose by His Majesty the King, the Treasurer may direct that the whole, or such part as in the circumstances he deems just, of the allowance which would otherwise have been payable to the Governor under this section in respect of that period shall be paid to the Lieutenant-Governor or other person administering the government of the State.

(4) This section, without further appropriation, shall be sufficient authority for the payment from year to year by the Treasurer out of the general revenue of the State of the allowance prescribed by this section.

(5) This section shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-three, and any arrears of the said allowance payable by virtue of this sub-section shall be paid in one sum as soon as is convenient after the enactment of this section.
