An Act to amend the Companies Act, 1962-1964.

[Assented to 25th November, 1965.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Companies Act Amendment Act, 1965" and shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
- (2) The Companies Act, 1962-1964, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Companies Act, 1962-1965".
- (3) The Companies Act, 1962-1964, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, Second Schedule.

- 3. The second schedule to the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) in item 3 thereof—
 - (i) by inserting after the word "amount" where secondly occurring therein the passage "of the fee";
 - (ii) by striking out the passage "on first registration" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "under this Act for registration of the company";

- (iii) by inserting after the word "amount" where thirdly occurring therein the passage "of the fee";
- (iv) by inserting after the word "payable" where secondly occurring therein the passage "under this Act for registration of the company";
- (b) in item 12 thereof by inserting after the word "every" the passage "application for a";
- (c) in item 39 thereof by striking out the figures "2 0 0" and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "3 0 0".
