An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1934-1963.

[Assented to 25th November, 1965.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1965".

(2) The Constitution Act, 1934-1963, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Constitution Act, 1934-1965".

(3) The Constitution Act, 1934-1963, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 55—
Standing Rules and Orders.**

3. Subsection (3) of section 55 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the words "two hundred" therein the words "and fifty".

Operation.

4. The amendment made by this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of November, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.

5. The arrears of salary payable to any person by reason of the amendment made by this Act may be paid in one sum and this Act shall without further appropriation be sufficient authority for the payment of any such arrears.
