An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1934, as amended.

[Assented to 19th November, 1970]

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**Short titles.**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Act Amendment Act (No. 3), 1970".

(2) The Constitution Act, 1934-1969, as amended by this Act and by all Acts amending the same prior to the enactment of this Act, may be cited as the "Constitution Act, 1934-1970".

(3) The Constitution Act, 1934-1969, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 65 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the word "nine" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "ten";

and

(b) by striking out from subsection (2) the word "six" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "seven".
