An Act to amend the Cremation Act, 1891.

[Assented to 21 April 1988]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Cremation Act Amendment Act, 1988.
- (2) The Cremation Act, 1891, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Substitution of s. 1

- 2. Section 1 of the principal Act is repealed and the following sections are substituted:

 Short title
 - 1. This Act may be cited as the Cremation Act, 1891.

Interpretation

- 1a. In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—
 - "crematorium" means a place for the cremation of human remains:
 - "registrar" means-
 - (a) the Principal Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages;
 - (b) the Deputy Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages;

(c) a district registrar of births, deaths, and marriages.
