### No. 93 of 1972

An Act to amend the Cigarettes (Labelling) Act, 1971.

[Assented to 9th November, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cigarettes (Labelling) Act Amendment Act, 1972". Short titles.

(2) The Cigarettes (Labelling) Act, 1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Cigarettes (Labelling) Act, 1971-1972".

(3) The Cigarettes (Labelling) Act, 1971, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day fixed by proclamation for the purposes of section 2 of the principal Act or if that day has already occurred before the enactment of this Act this Act shall for all purposes be deemed to have come into operation on that day. Commencement.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (a) the passage "section 3" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "section 4".
