An Act to amend the Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1971

[Assented to 30th March, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1972".
- (2) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1972".
- (3) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1971, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Commence-

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4a—
Proclamation of disease, etc.

- 3. Section 4a of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "proclaimed as such by a previous proclamation";
 - (b) by inserting in subsection (2) after the passage "this Act" first occurring the passage "and upon the publication of that proclamation that disease shall cease to be a disease as defined in subsection (1) of section 4 of this Act;

(c) by striking out from subsection (2) the second sentence therein;

and

- (d) by inserting immediately after subsection (2), as amended, the following subsection:—
 - (3) At any time after a disease has, pursuant to a proclamation under this section, ceased to be a disease as defined in subsection (1) of section 4 of this Act, the Governor may by proclamation under subsection (1) of this section declare that disease to be a disease for the purposes of this Act.
