An Act to amend the Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1972.

[Assented to 11th April, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1974".
- (2) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1972, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1974".

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of July, 1974.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 11— Establishment of Cattle Compensation Fund.

3. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (b) from subsection (3).

Amendment of principal Act, s. 13— Duty on sales of cattle.

- 4. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—
 - (2) On and after the commencement of the Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1974, for every head of cattle or carcass sold, whether singly or in a lot, there shall be payable stamp duty at the rate of five cents for each twenty dollars or part thereof of the amount of purchase money paid in respect of such head of cattle or carcass or fifty cents whichever amount of stamp duty is the lesser amount.
