**An Act to amend the Cattle Compensation Act,
1939-1951.**

[Assented to 6th December, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1951".

(2) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1951".

(3) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1951, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 6 of the principal Act (as amended by section 4 of the Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1948) is amended by striking out the word "thirty" in the last line of subsection (1) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "sixty".
