An Act to amend the Cattle Compensation Act,
1939-1970.

[Assented to 18th November, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1971". Short title.

(2) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1970, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1971".

(3) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1970, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the definition of "cattle" and inserting in lieu thereof the following definition:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 4— Interpretation.

"cattle" means any animal of the genus *bos* or any animal of the genus *bubalus*..
