An Act to amend "The Crown Lands Amendment Act, 1882."

[Assented to, February 28th, 1884.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to extend the time provided by Preamble.
"The Crown Lands Amendment Act, 1882," for the surrender by selectors of existing agreements—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

The second section of "The Crown Lands Amendment Act, 1882," shall be read as if the words "thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four," had been inserted in the said section in lieu of the words "first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three." Substitution of March 31st, 1884, for December 1st, 1883, in sec. 2 of Act No. 275 of 1882.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
