An Act to suspend the operation of certain provisions of the Crown Lands Act, 1915.

[*Assented to, December 2nd, 1915.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the "Crown Lands Act Suspendory Act, 1915." Short title.

2. This Act is incorporated with the Crown Lands Act, 1915, and that Act and this Act shall be read together as one Act. Incorporation with other Acts.

3. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Crown Lands Act, 1915, or in any Act thereby repealed, in any case where the Receiver of Rents, pursuant to the provisions of section 166 of the Crown Lands Act, 1903, or section 196 of the Crown Lands Act, 1915, has heretofore extended or hereafter extends the time for payment of an amount due under an agreement, in consequence of the effects of the recent drought or the present war, no interest shall be charged on such amount, as required by the said section 166 or the said section 196, in respect of the period between the day whereon such amount fell or falls due and the fourth day of January, nineteen hundred and sixteen. Interest not to be charged where time for payment of amounts due under agreements extended.

Crown Lands Act Suspensory Act.—1915.

(2) If such amount, or any part thereof, remains unpaid after the said fourth day of January, interest shall be charged on such amount or part from that day until payment thereof at the rate specified in the said section 196.
