An Act to further suspend the operation of certain provisions of the Consolidated Stock and Sinking Fund Act, 1896.

[Assented to, November 16th, 1916.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Consolidated Stock and Sinking Fund Act Further Suspension Act, 1916." Short title.

2. This Act is incorporated with the Consolidated Stock and Sinking Fund Act, 1896, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with other Acts. No. 648 of 1896.

3. Notwithstanding section 18 of the Consolidated Stock and Sinking Fund Act, 1896, it shall not be obligatory to make any payment to the Public Debt Commissioners pursuant to the said section until the financial year next after the close of the period of twelve months next after the notification by the Governor in the *Government Gazette* of the signing on behalf of the United Kingdom of a treaty of peace terminating the war now existing in Europe. Section 18 of Act 648 of 1896 not to apply during present war.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
