**An Act to amend the Consumer Transactions Act, 1972-1982.**

*[Assented to 16 June 1983]*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Consumer Transactions Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1983".

(2) The Consumer Transactions Act, 1972-1982, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Consumer Transactions Act, 1972-1983".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 8—  
Conditions and warranties to be implied in consumer contracts.

3. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (7).
