An Act to amend the Foot and Mouth Disease Eradication Fund Act, 1958.

[Assented to 10th November, 1965.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Foot and Mouth Disease Eradication Fund Act Amendment Act, 1965".

(2) The Foot and Mouth Disease Eradication Fund Act, 1958, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Foot and Mouth Disease Eradication Fund Act, 1958-1965".

(3) The Foot and Mouth Disease Eradication Fund Act, 1958, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, 5.3— Interpretation.

3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "animal" therein the following definition :—

"foot and mouth disease" includes vesicular exanthema and vesicular stomatitis.
