**An Act to amend the Friendly Societies Act,
1919-1938.**

[Assented to 21st November, 1940.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Friendly Societies Act Amendment Act, 1940".

(2) The Friendly Societies Act, 1919-1938, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Friendly Societies Act, 1919-1940".

(3) The Friendly Societies Act, 1919-1938, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after paragraph III. of subsection (1) thereof the following paragraph:—

IIIa. For providing dental attendance for, and the selling or supplying of artificial dentures or other dental devices or requisites to, the members, their husbands, wives, widows, children, fathers, mothers, brothers, sisters, nephews, nieces, widowed mothers of deceased members, and wards of members (being orphans):
