## An Act to amend the Health Act, 1935-1966.

[Assented to 30th March, 1967.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Health Act Amendment Act, 1967".
- (2) The Health Act, 1935-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Health Act, 1935-1967".
- (3) The Health Act, 1935-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 127— Report of infectious disease.

- 3. (1) Section 127 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by inserting after the word "disease" last occurring in subsection (1) thereof the passage "(other than gonorrhoea and syphilis)";

and

- (b) by inserting after the word "disease" second occurring in subsection (3) thereof the passage "(other than gonorrhoea and syphilis)".
- (2) The amendments effected by subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have come into operation upon the commencement of the Health Act Amendment Act, 1966.
